



## Description générale

Atropine is a muscarinic antagonist with multiple therapeutic indications including reduction of salivary and bronchial secretions during surgical procedures, treatment of organophosphate poisoning, and as a cycloplegic and mydriatic agent following topical administration into the eye.

Section Preoperative medication and sedation for short-term procedures

Parenteral > General injections > unspecified: 1 mg in 1 mL ampoule (atropine sulfate)

Parasympatholytics [anticholinergics and antimuscarinics] and spasmolytics

Section Antidotes and other substances used in poisonings > Specific

Parenteral > General injections > unspecified: 1 mg in 1 mL ampoule (atropine sulfate)

Indications

Exposure to or harmful effects of undetermined intent of pesticides

Local > Ophthalmological > Solution (eye drops): 0.1% (sulfate); 0.5% (sulfate); 1% (sulfate)
