



## General description

The combination of lidocaine and epinephrine (adrenaline) is used as a local anaesthetic for surface anaesthesia of mucous membranes, infiltration anaesthesia, peripheral and sympathetic nerve block, dental anaesthesia, spinal anaesthesia, and intravenous regional anaesthesia.

Parenteral > Locoregional injections > Other: 1% (lidocaine hydrochloride OR lidocaine sulfate) + 1:200 000 epinephrine; 2% (lidocaine hydrochloride OR lidocaine sulfate) + 1:200 000 epinephrine  
Local > Dental > Cartridge: 2% (lidocaine hydrochloride) + 1:80 000 epinephrine
