Section Medicines for other common symptoms in palliative care

Parenteral > General injections > IV: 2 mg per mL in 2 mL ampoule (ondansetron base, as hydrochloride)
Oral > Liquid: 4 mg per 5 mL (ondansetron base)
Oral > Solid: 4 mg (ondansetron base); 8 mg (ondansetron base)

Section Antiemetic medicines

Parenteral > General injections > IV: 2 mg per mL in 2 mL ampoule (ondansetron base, as hydrochloride)
Oral > Liquid: 4 mg per 5 mL (ondansetron base)
