## Recommendations

### Section Access group antibiotics

Oral > Liquid: 250 mg per 5 mL (as potassium salt) powder for oral liquid

Oral > Solid: 250 mg (as potassium salt); 500 mg (as potassium salt)

Oral > Solid: 250 mg (as potassium salt) tablet

### Indications

#### First choice

Periapical abscess without sinus

Bacterial pneumonia (Community-acquired pneumonia - mild to moderate)

Acute pharyngitis

#### Other indications

Bacterial infection of unspecified site
