Section Watch group antibiotics

Oral > Liquid: 125 mg per 5 mL powder for oral liquid; 250 mg per 5 mL powder for oral liquid

Oral > Solid: 500 mg

Parenteral > General injections > unspecified: 500 mg in vial powder for injection
