Isoniazid, also known as isonicotinyldrazide (INH), is an antibiotic often used for the treatment of latent and active tuberculosis. It can be used in combination with other medicines active against tuberculosis - rifampicin, pyrazinamide, and either streptomycin or ethambutol.
