Zidovudine (ZDV), also known as azidothymidine (AZT), is an antiretroviral medication used to prevent and treat human immunodeficiency virus (HIV) disease.

Recommandations

Section Antiretrovirals > Nucleoside/Nucleotide reverse transcriptase inhibitors

Parenteral > General injections > IV: 10 mg per mL in 20 mL vial solution for IV infusion
Oral > Liquid: 50 mg per 5 mL
Oral > Solid > tablet: 300 mg
Oral > Solid > capsule: 250 mg

Human immunodeficiency virus disease without mention of associated disease or condition, clinical stage unspecified
