Paromomycin is an antimicrobial medicine used in the treatment of leishmaniasis and some parasitic infections.

## Recommendations

### Section Antileishmaniasis medicines

Parenteral > General injections > IM: 750 mg paromomycin base (as sulfate)

### Section Antiamoebic and antigiardiasis medicines

Oral > Liquid: 125 mg per 5 mL as sulfate

Oral > Solid: 250 mg as sulfate
