Sodium thiosulfate is used in combination with sodium nitrite in the treatment of cyanide poisoning.

## Recommendations

### Section     Antidotes and other substances used in poisonings > Specific

Parenteral > General injections > IV: 250 mg per mL in 50 mL ampoule
