Section

Preoperative medication and sedation for short-term procedures
Parenteral > General injections > unspecified: 1 mg in 1 mL ampoule
(atropine sulfate)

Indications

Parasympatholytics [anticholinergics and antimuscarinics] and spasmolytics

Midazolam

Section

Preoperative medication and sedation for short-term procedures
Parenteral > General injections > IV: 1 mg per mL
Oral > Liquid: 2 mg per mL
Oral > Solid > dosage form: 15 mg; 7.5 mg

Indications

Sedative-hypnotic and anxiolytic drugs

Morphine

Section

Preoperative medication and sedation for short-term procedures
Parenteral > General injections > IV: 10 mg in 1 mL ampoule (morphine hydrochloride or morphine sulfate)

Indications

Opioids or related analgesics and agents affecting opioid receptors
