## Cetirizine

## Dexamethasone

Section	Indications
Antiallergics and medicines used in anaphylaxis Parenteral > General injections > unspecified: 4 mg per mL in 1 mL ampoule (as disodium phosphate salt)	Allergic or hypersensitivity conditions of unspecified type

## Epinephrine

Section	Indications
Antiallergics and medicines used in anaphylaxis Parenteral > General injections > unspecified: 1 mg in 1 mL ampoule (as hydrochloride or hydrogen tartrate)	Anaphylaxis

## Fexofenadine

Section	Indications
Antiallergics and medicines used in anaphylaxis	Therapeutic equivalent to loratadine pour Allergic or hypersensitivity conditions of unspecified type

## Hydrocortisone

Section	Indications
Antiallergics and medicines used in anaphylaxis Parenteral > General injections > unspecified: 100 mg in vial powder for injection (as sodium succinate)	Anaphylaxis

## Loratadine

Section	Indications
Antiallergics and medicines used in anaphylaxis Oral > Liquid: 1 mg per mL Oral > Solid: 10 mg	Allergic or hypersensitivity conditions of unspecified type

## Prednisolone

Section	Indications
Antiallergics and medicines used in anaphylaxis	Allergic or hypersensitivity conditions of unspecified type
Oral > Liquid: 5 mg per mL	
Oral > Solid: 5 mg; 25 mg
