Oral &gt; Liquid: 125 mg powder for oral suspension (in sachet)

Oral &gt; Solid: 80 mg; 125 mg; 165 mg

Nausea or vomiting

Oral &gt; Liquid: 0.5 mg per 5 mL; 2 mg per 5 mL

Oral &gt; Solid: 0.5 mg; 0.75 mg; 1.5 mg; 4 mg

Parenteral &gt; General injections &gt; unspecified: 4 mg per mL in 1 mL ampoule (as disodium phosphate salt)

Oral &gt; Liquid: 5 mg per 5 mL

Oral &gt; Solid: 10 mg (hydrochloride)

Parenteral &gt; General injections &gt; unspecified: 5 mg per mL in 2 mL ampoule (hydrochloride)

## Indications

Nausea or vomiting

## Ondansetron

### Section

#### Antiemetic medicines

Parenteral > General injections > IV: 2 mg per mL in 2 mL ampoule (ondansetron base, as hydrochloride)

Oral > Liquid: 4 mg per 5 mL (ondansetron base)

Oral > Solid: 4 mg (ondansetron base); 8 mg (ondansetron base); 24 mg (ondansetron base)

Parenteral > General injections > unspecified: 25 mg per mL in 2 mL ampoule
