Medicines for nicotine use disorders
Local > Topical > Transdermal patch: 5 to 30 mg per 16 hour; 7 to 21 mg per 24 hour
Oral > Solid > lozenge: 2 mg; 4 mg lozenge
Local > Buccal > Oral spray: 1 mg per actuation
Local > Buccal > Chewing gum: 2 mg; 4 mg
