Watch group antibiotics Oral > Liquid: 200 mg per 5 mL (anhydrous) powder for oral liquid Oral > Solid > dosage form: 250 mg (anhydrous); 500 mg (anhydrous)	First choice Chlamydia trachomatis Typhoid fever Yaws Paratyphoid fever Cholera Cholera [children] Trachoma
	co-prescribed with ceftriaxone Gonococcal infection
	Second choice Infectious gastroenteritis or colitis without specification of infectious agent
	co-prescribed with cefixime Gonococcal infection
