Cetirizine

Dexamethasone

Epinephrine

Antiallergics and medicines used in anaphylaxis Parenteral > General injections > unspecified: 1 mg in 1 mL ampoule (as hydrochloride or hydrogen tartrate)	Anaphylaxis

Fexofenadine

Antiallergics and medicines used in anaphylaxis	Therapeutic equivalent to loratadine for Allergic or hypersensitivity conditions of unspecified type

Hydrocortisone

Antiallergics and medicines used in anaphylaxis Parenteral > General injections > unspecified: 100 mg in vial powder for injection (as sodium succinate)	Anaphylaxis

Loratadine

Antiallergics and medicines used in anaphylaxis Oral > Liquid: 1 mg per mL Oral > Solid: 10 mg	Allergic or hypersensitivity conditions of unspecified type

Prednisolone
