Medicines for disorders of the pituitary hormone system Parenteral > General injections > IM: 20 mg in vial (modified-release, as acetate) plus diluent Parenteral > General injections > SC: 0.05 mg per mL in 1 mL vial (immediate-release, as acetate); 0.1 mg per mL in 1 mL vial (immediate-release, as acetate); 0.5 mg per mL in 1 mL vial (immediate-release, as acetate)	<a href="#">Acromegaly or pituitary gigantism</a>
