Anti-d immunoglobulin

Section	Indications
Human immunoglobulins	Maternal care for red cell antibodies
Parenteral > General injections > IV: 250 µg in single-dose vial	Rh incompatibility reaction
Parenteral > General injections > IM: 250 µg in single-dose vial	

Anti-rabies immunoglobulin

Section	Indications
Human immunoglobulins	Rabies
Parenteral > General injections > IM: 150 IU per mL in vial	
Parenteral > Locoregional injections > Other: 150 IU per mL in vial	

Anti-tetanus immunoglobulin

Section	Indications
Human immunoglobulins	Tetanus
Parenteral > General injections > IM: 500 IU in vial	

C1 esterase inhibitor

Section	Indications
Plasma-derived medicines	Hereditary angioedema
Parenteral > General injections > IV: 500 IU in vial powder for injection	

Normal immunoglobulin

Section	Indications
Human immunoglobulins	Primary immunodeficiencies
Parenteral > General injections > IV: 5% protein solution; 10% protein solution	Mucocutaneous lymph node syndrome
Parenteral > General injections > IM: 16% protein solution	Langerhans cell histiocytosis
Parenteral > General injections > SC: 15% protein solution; 16% protein solution
