Section

Ear, nose and throat medicines [c]

- Local > Otological > drops: 0.3% (as hydrochloride)

Watch group antibiotics

- Parenteral > General injections > IV: 2 mg per mL (as hyclate)
- Oral > Liquid: 250 mg per 5 mL (anhydrous)
- Oral > Solid > dosage form: 250 mg (as hydrochloride); 500 mg (as hydrochloride); 100 mg (as hydrochloride)
- Oral > Solid > dosage form: 250 mg (as hydrochloride); 500 mg (as hydrochloride)
- Oral > Solid: 250 mg (as hydrochloride)

Indications

Infectious diseases of external ear

First choice

Acute pyelonephritis (mild to moderate)

Paratyphoid fever

Typhoid fever

Infectious gastroenteritis or colitis without specification of infectious agent

Neutropaenia (low-risk)

Inflammatory or other diseases of prostate (mild to moderate)

Second choice

Cholera

Cholera [children]

co-prescribed with metronidazole

Peritoneal abscess (mild-moderate)

co-prescribed with metronidazole

Peritonitis (mild-moderate)

Bacterial infection of unspecified site
