Furosemide**Section**

Diuretics

- Parenteral > General injections > IV: 10 mg per mL in 2 mL ampoule; 10 mg per mL in 5 mL ampoule
- Oral > Liquid: 20 mg per 5 mL; 50 mg per 5 mL
- Oral > Solid > tablet: 40 mg; 20 mg
