Section	Indications
Solutions correcting water, electrolyte and acid-base disturbances > Oral ◦ Powder for dilution in 200 mL, 500 mL, 1 L: ◦ ◦ - glucose 75 mEq or mmol/L ◦ - sodium 75 mEq or mmol/L ◦ - chloride 65 mEq or mmol/L ◦ - potassium 20 mEq or mmol/L ◦ - citrate 10 mEq or mmol/L ◦ - osmolarity 245 mOsm/L ◦ - glucose 13.5 g/L ◦ - sodium chloride 2.6 g/L ◦ - potassium chloride 1.5 g/L ◦ - trisodium citrate dihydrate 2.9 g/L	Other specified disorders of fluid, electrolyte or acid-base balance
