Medicines for acute migraine attacks

- Oral > Liquid: 100 mg per 5 mL; 200 mg per 5 mL
- Oral > Solid > tablet: 200 mg; 400 mg

Medicines administered to the neonate [c]

- Parenteral > General injections > IV: 5 mg per mL

Non-opioids and non-steroidal anti-inflammatory medicines (NSAIDs)

- Oral > Liquid: 200 mg per 5 mL; 100 mg per 5 mL
- Oral > Solid > tablet: 200 mg; 400 mg; 600 mg
