- Local > Topical > Solution: 5% (digluconate) for dilution

- Local > Topical > Powder: 0.1% available chlorine for solution
- Local > Topical > Liquid: 0.1% available chlorine for solution
- Local > Topical > Solid: 0.1% available chlorine for solution
