Following the review of square box listings on the EML and EMLc, the Expert Committee recommended that medicines in 4th level ATC chemical subgroup, D01AC Imidazole and triazole derivatives (excluding combinations), be specified as therapeutic alternatives under the square box listing for miconazole on the EML and EMLc.
