In 2015, as part of the comprehensive review of cancer medicines undertaken by the Expert Committee, listing for ifosfamide on the complementary list of the EML for use in treatment protocols for ovarian germ cell tumour was specifically endorsed. Additionally, ifosfamide was included on the complementary list of the EMLc for this indication.
