Summary of evidence and Expert Committee recommendations

Following the review of the age-appropriateness of formulations on the EMLc, the Expert Committee recommended the addition of new formulations of azathioprine (oral liquid 10 mg/mL, powder for injection 50 mg, and tablet 25 mg) to the EMLc.
