Summary of evidence and Expert Committee recommendations



The Committee accepted the recommendation of the WHO Department of Vaccines and Biologicals to modify the list of essential vaccines to list the antigens but not the specific vaccine mixtures. The reason is that there are various combination products intended for different groups of people and that listing all of the recommended vaccines would unduly complicate the list. Specific therapeutic recommendations for vaccines containing single antigens or mixtures of antigens are found in the policy statements of the WHO Department of Vaccines and Biologicals.
