### Summary of evidence and Expert Committee recommendations

The Committee noted the lack of need for an emetic in the treatment of poisoning due to the risk of aspiration pneumonia, and the absence of evidence on the efficacy and safety of ipecacuanha in the management of poisoning. The Committee further noted that ipecacuanha is not included in the International Programme for Chemical Safety (IPCS) INTOX databank and thus recommended that it be deleted from the Model List.
